





# 2025 Write to Educate Essay Contest

LAFCU is seeking seniors attending high school in Michigan to participate in our annual Write to Educate essay contest. Students attending an accredited college or university in the state of Michigan in the Fall of 2025 should apply.

#### TASK:

Write a one-page 500 word essay (essays not meeting 500 word count or exceeding one-page will be excluded from scoring)

- Typed in Times New Roman
- 12 point font
- Single spaced
- One-inch margins
- Do not include your name or school name in your essay

#### TOPIC:

If you could create a new course to teach in high schools, what would it be and why would it be beneficial to students?

#### **GRADING:**

Students will be graded using a 1-10 point scale with the following criteria:

- Specifically followed the requirements and directions of the essay contest
- Content
- Correct spelling/grammar
