Winners direct additional \$1,000 to charities; application deadline April 15

LANSING, Mich. — LAFCU is accepting applications for its 2017 "Write to Educate" Essay Contest that will award two \$2,500 college scholarships to high school seniors and allow them each to select a local charity to receive a \$500 donation from LAFCU. One scholarship is for a student who will attend Baker College's Owosso campus; the other is for a student who will attend Lansing Community College.
